3. Advanced Flight / Safer Flying Right from the Start, Ages 13-18

- Dates July 22-26 from 9AM - 12PM (*Class is limited to 12 participants*)
- 3 hours per session, taught by Certificated Flight and Ground Instructors.
- Ground school programming includes:
 - o Loss of control: accident review, stall discussion, importance & review of SOP.
 - o Weather data: Metar, TAF, Airmet, Sigmet, Pireps.
 - o Electronic Flight Bag usage:
 - o Overview, SOP, use philosophy -preflight briefings.
 - o Runway incursion discussion: definitions, airport markings, best practices, etc., accident review
- Private Pilot Checkride oral review presented by an FAA Pilot Examiner
- Also includes flight club t-shirt, online FAA textbook, use of Redbird Simulator and tours of the Bowman Control Tower and Louisville International Airport (SDF)

4. 3 Day Private Pilot Written Exam Preparation, Ages 15-18

- Dates July 18th from 6PM - 9PM, July 18th and July 19th from 8AM - 5PM. (*Class is limited to 12 participants*)
- You will receive an endorsement for the written exam from the instructor at the end of class. Your passing score (70%) on the Written Test is good for twenty-four (24) calendar-months. The exam contains 60 questions. These questions are chosen randomly from over 900 questions in the exam database. You are allowed 2 1/2 hours to complete the exam. Taught by Certificated Flight and Ground Instructors.
- Taught by CFI: Angie Bartley, The Ground School Guru
- You will receive an endorsement for the written exam from the instructor at the end of class. Your passing score (70%) on the Written Test is good for twenty-four (24) calendar-months. The exam contains 60 questions. These questions are chosen randomly from over 900 questions in the exam database. You are allowed 2 1/2 hours to complete the exam.
 - o This course is designed to prepare the student pilot to pass the FAA Private Pilot Knowledge Test in preparation for his or her Private Pilot knowledge exam. Your passing score (70%) on the Private Pilot Written Test is good for twenty-four (24) calendar-months from the successful day achieved.
